Brief description of the partner:	Vilnius Gediminas Technical University (VGTU) is one of the biggest universities in Lithuania and the only technical higher education institution in the capital city of Vilnius. Its history dates back to 1956. The institution attained the university status in 1990. A few years later, in 1996 the university got the name of Gediminas, the Grand Duke of Lithuania.
	<ul> <li>More numbers of interest to introduce VGTU are the following:</li> <li>over 40 programmes for Bachelor's degree with 11500 students (4 years), up to 40 programmes for Master's degree with 3 000 students (2 years)</li> <li>about 30 programmes for Doctor's degree with 250 students (4 years) in the areas of technical, natural, social sciences and humanities.</li> <li>researchers and academic staff total in 876 persons (female staff- 45 %), including 120 professors, 370 associate professors, and 250 lecturers and assistants. Professor-student ratio is 1:15</li> </ul>
	The advantage of Vilnius Gediminas Technical University that distinguishes the university among other Lithuanian institutions (total number of higher education institutions in Lithuania is 15) is the wide offer of the courses in English, i.e. full programmes-8 undergraduate and 4 postgraduate ones.
